I have worked with metal since 1989. Starting out in welding school, becoming a specialized tig welder and later a fully ticketed welder/ pipe fitter and Atomic Radiation worker, which lead to blacksmithing and construction of forms. Since then I have worked on airoplanes and have also been introduced to jewellery through my BFA at NSCAD. An apprenticeship with artist and conservationist William Lishman opened up the world of sculpture, flight, and migrating geese. I continue to work at NSCAD, as well as in my home-based studio.”</p>
